This is a firm deadline – make sure that you have filed your dissertation and completed all the necessary paperwork with Fredonia Thompson – otherwise, you are ineligible to participate in the 2017 Commencement Exercises in the May.

Common MA Students - Please note, you will still need to complete coursework during the Spring 2017 semester, which will continue after you file your thesis and after you participate in the ceremony.
